## Find hospitals that are covered under your plan.

• Go to Find a Provider/Provider Search.



• Select your location, then your Plan/Network. Click Continue.



• Choose the Hospital icon. The hospitals in your plan's network will display.

- Select View Details on the hospital you want to look at.
  - Then select the Cal Hospital Compare link to reach CalHospitalCompare.org.
  - In the Compare Hospital search field, enter a hospital's name or your ZIP code. Click the search icon.



• Click on the hospital's name in the left bar. A page of information on the hospital will open.

- Explore the different types of ratings for the hospital.
  - Areas of care are available to click on. The hospital's performance vs. the state average will display.
  - If the hospital is on an Honor Roll, the specific Honor Roll icon will be displayed on the page.
