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

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A Review of PACE





AltaMed Health Services and Brandman Centers for Senior Care (PACE)

Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly

An integrated Health Plan/Medical Group designed to provide complete access to Medical, Social, Psychological, Transportation, Homecare, Nutritional, Rehabilitative services, End of life through one comprehensive program.

VERTICAL INTEGRATION AT PROVIDER LEVEL

A provider-based Medicare and Medi-Cal managed care system

Integrates acute and long-term care funding and delivery systems for nursing home certified seniors

Uses *Interdisciplinary Teams* to assess need, provide and manage care

Receives monthly *capitated* payments for a full range of services and assumes full risk

PACE Payment Option for Coverage



IF YOU ARE ELIGIBLE FOR:	THEN YOU WILL PAY:
Medi-Cal and MediCare	No Cost
Medi-Cal with No Share of Cost	No Cost
Medi-Cal Share of Cost	Monthly Fee equal to your share of cost payment to PACE
MediCare Only	Monthly Fees to PACE if not eligible for Medi-Cal
Private Pay	Monthly Fee determined by PACE

What is PACE and Who Qualifies

PACE Eligibility:


- 55 years old or older
- Live in the service area of a PACE organization: 133 Zipcodes
- Certified by the state to meet the need for skilled nursing home level of care
- Able to live safely in the community with the help of PACE services

Assessment:

- Interdisciplinary Team conducts evaluation to determine eligibility and develop care plans and manage chronic conditions
- Annual and semi-annual reassessment to review status
- Unscheduled reassessment based upon significant change in participants health/psychosocial status

Efficient Use of Health Care Resources

- personal care
- prescription drugs
- social services
- audiology
- dentistry
- optometry

- home health care
- Medical professionals (Inclusive of Geriatricians)

- Two new PACE Sites Opening in South LA and Covina 2014




ALTAMED-PACE PROGRAM

- ~1600 patients
- 24 Providers (100 Patients/Provider panel)
- 8 Sites
- Patients at PACE Center ~9 days/month
- ~80% patients receive maintenance PT-OT
- 14 Transportation round trips/month/pt
- ~20 Meals/month/pt
- ~70 Caregiver support service hrs/month/pt



RISK ADJUSTED SCORING


HCC Scores

Beddays/1000



QUALITY MEASURES

- Pneumococcal vaccine rate = 96%
- Nephropathy screening in Diabetes = 96%
- Hospital Discharge f/u visit within 48hrs = 100%
- Readmit rate = 12%
- Patient Satisfaction-Would refer friend/family = 96%



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Brandman Centers for Senior Care Specifics



BCSC Facts

- Generously funded by Joyce and Saul (of blessed memory) Brandman
- Once at capacity the first BCSC center will serve 180 participants
- Philosophy: Provide affordable, high-quality health and long-term care services for the well-being of participants and the communities we serve.



About BCSC Participants

- ~90 patients at 1 site (expansion coming soon)
- Average number of medical diagnoses: *11*
- Diagnosis of dementia: *36%*
- Average number of ADL impairment: *3.2*
 - % with 3 or more ADL's: *67%*
 - % with 5 or more ADL's: *25%*
- Home care recipients: *38%*
- Home health recipients: *14%*
- Center attendance ~9 days/month
- Overall BCSC patient satisfaction slightly above the CalPACE average (89% for BCSC vs. 88% for CalPACE)



Hospital Utilization

- 3 Primary Care Providers (49 network providers, two ancillary providers and 31 organizations/institutions contracted to provide additional care)
- Non Psychiatric Inpatient Hospital Days:
 - Acute days per 1,000 = 1,961
 - Average length of stay = 4.92 days
- Including inpatient psychiatric care:
 - Acute days per 1,000 = 2,427
 - Average length of stay = 5.62 days
- Readmission at 30 days = 0%
(=1.5% for inpatient psychiatric care only)



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How does PACE fit into the Coordinated Care Initiative?



Medi-Medi Beneficiaries

Your options:

- 1. Enroll in Cal MediConnect**
 - Combine your Medicare and Medi-Cal benefits under one plan
- 2. Opt out of Cal MediConnect**
 - Your Medicare remains the same (fee-for-service or Medicare Advantage plan)
 - You **must** enroll in a Medi-Cal plan for your Medi-Cal benefits
- 3. Enroll in PACE**

Medi-Cal Only Beneficiaries

Those who are not eligible for Cal MediConnect or who opt out still must enroll in a Medi-Cal managed care plan.

Your
Options:

1. Enroll in Medi-Cal managed care plan

- All current Medi-Cal benefits
- IHSS, CBAS, MSSP and nursing facility care
- Non-emergency medical transportation
- Medicare share of cost, wrap-around benefits

2. Enroll in PACE

How to Select the PACE Option

- If you are age 55 or older and live in an applicable zip code, then PACE may be a choice for you.
- If PACE is listed on your Health Plan Choice Form and you pick a PACE plan you must also pick a Cal MediConnect plan from the list **or** a Medi-Cal plan from - this is just in case you do not qualify to join PACE.
- PACE programs receive updates every week from the State regarding who has requested PACE enrollment.
- PACE programs have 60 days to process enrollment
- You can enroll, disenroll from a PACE plan at any time.
